Lego[®] Prayer



You will need:

One Lego[®] or Duplo[®] brick per person. (Note: use either Lego or Duplo, but not a mixture.)

Instructions

1. Hold your brick

Pray for yourself. Thank God for the things he has given you, especially the opportunity to read or hear about Jesus from the Bible.

2. Count the bumps on your brick

For each bump on your brick, pray for a different country in the world. Ask God to bless them with godly leaders, peace and justice, and that



people would be able to access the Bible in a language that they can read and understand.

3. Find someone who has a different colour brick to you and swap bricks

Thank God for making each person different. Thank him for all the different people who work in Bible translation: those serving with Wycliffe, local translators, office staff, IT staff, staff who care for children and families, and training staff.

4. Find someone with the same number of bumps on their brick as you

Thank God for children and their families who work in other countries. Ask God to keep them safe and that they would grow in faith.

5. Put all of the bricks together and build a structure or tower with them

Thank God for the Church and all those who work in Bible translation. Pray that he would help us all work together so other people can have a Bible in the language they can read and understand best.
